

Wirbelwind Medium Anti Aircraft Tank – 175 points

In Service: 1944 **Availability:** R **Asset:** Support

The Flakpanzer IV Wirbelwind (“Whirlwind”) was a rapid deployable anti-aircraft tank based on the widespread Panzer IV chassis. It was developed in 1944 as a successor to the earlier Möbelwagen. Because of its armour and rapid fire from the four guns it was also very effective against infantry.

Armoured Cars

SdKfz 221 Panzerspähwagen – 70 points

In Service: 1936 **Availability:** C **Asset:** Support

The Leichter Panzerspähwagen was a series of light armoured cars used by the reconnaissance battalions of the Panzer divisions; it performed well enough in countries with good road networks, like those in Western Europe. However, on the Eastern Front and North Africa, it was hampered by its relatively poor off-road performance. The SdKfz 221 was armed with a single machine gun, manned by a two man crew, and had 4-wheel drive.

SdKfz 222 Panzerspähwagen – 110 points

This version of the vehicle was armed with the powerful 2cm L55 Gun.

SdKfz 231/232 8 Rad Panzerspähwagen – 110 points

In Service: 1936 (231); 1938 (232) **Availability:** UC **Asset:** Support

The 8 wheel armoured cars were intended as reconnaissance vehicles, scouting ahead of the Panzer tank units to assess enemy strength and intentions. They were a very fast addition to the German army of the early war years.

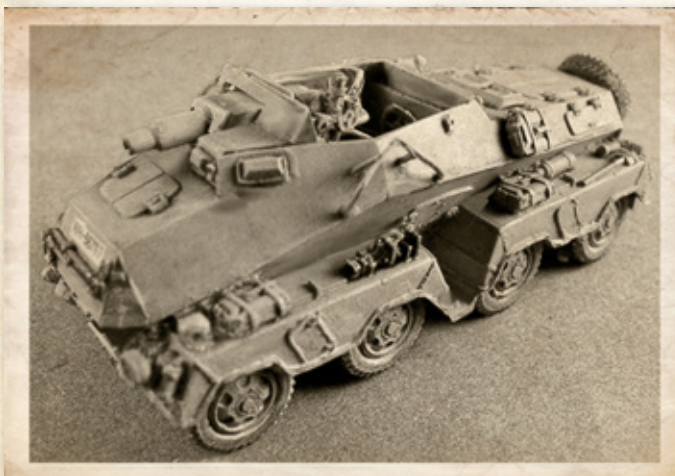

SdKfz 233 8 Rad Panzerspähwagen – 70 points

In Service: 1942 **Availability:** R **Asset:** Support

The SdKfz 233 featured the short barrelled 7.5 cm L24 gun. This variant of the SdKfz series entered service during 1942 and remained in use throughout the war. They were issued as support of reconnaissance battalions.

Armoured Cars

SdKfz 234/1 8 Rad Panzerspähwagen – 115 points

In Service: 1944 **Availability:** UC **Asset:** Support

The SdKfz 234/1 was fitted with the 2 cm L55 gun and coaxial machine gun in a rotating six-sided open turret (the open turret was protected from grenades by a mesh-covered frame).
