

## AEC Armoured Car – 135 points

**In Service:** 1942    **Availability:** UC    **Asset:** Support

Although armoured cars had quickly been adopted to take the Light Tank role, the earlier vehicles tended to have only light armament. It became evident that a design with a support weapon that could deal with enemy light armour was required and amongst those who took up this design challenge was the private venture by AEC. During a demonstration for Winston Churchill on Horse Guards Parade in 1941 they managed to introduce a mock-up of their design which won support from the Prime Minister leading to a production order.

The AEC Mk I was a large vehicle for an armoured car. It used the 2 pdr. Gun turret from the Valentine tank and was quite successful 1942 when used in North Africa.

Following the success of the Mk I, it was decided to upgrade the vehicle when the new 6 pdr. Gun became available. The opportunity was also taken to redesign the hull and to fit an improved diesel engine giving a top speed of 41mph. The final version of the AEC armoured car was the superb Mk III, featuring a redesigned Turret to take the 75mm gun.

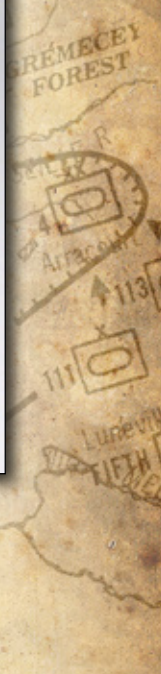
**Unit:** AEC (unit leader) with 2 pdr. Gun and one Co-Axial MG

**Options:**

- Up to 2 extra AEC may be added to the unit for +135 (Mk I) +140; Mk III + 150) points each.
- **AEC Mk II:** The AEC may be upgraded to the 1943 Mk II. This costs +5 points per vehicle and replaces the 2 pdr. Gun with a 6 pdr. Gun.
- **AEC Mk III:** The AEC may be upgraded to the 1944 Mk III. This costs +15 points per vehicle and replaces the 2 pdr. Gun with a 75mm tank Gun.

## Daimler Armoured Car – 95 points

**In Service:** 1942    **Availability:** C    **Asset:** Support

The Daimler Armoured Car was a larger version of the Dingo with the turret of the Tetrarch Light Tank; it featured a fully independent suspension system and a four wheel drive.
