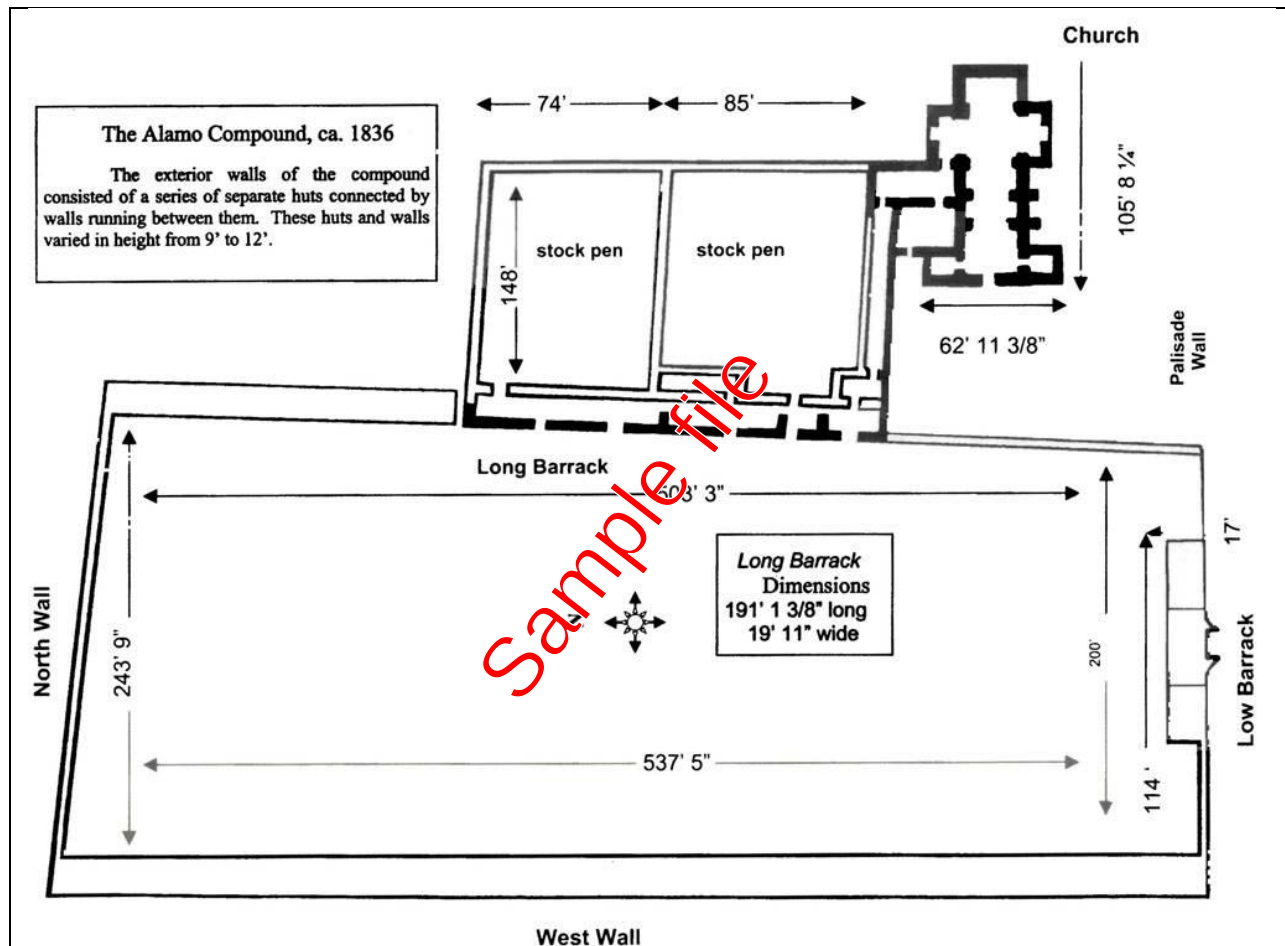


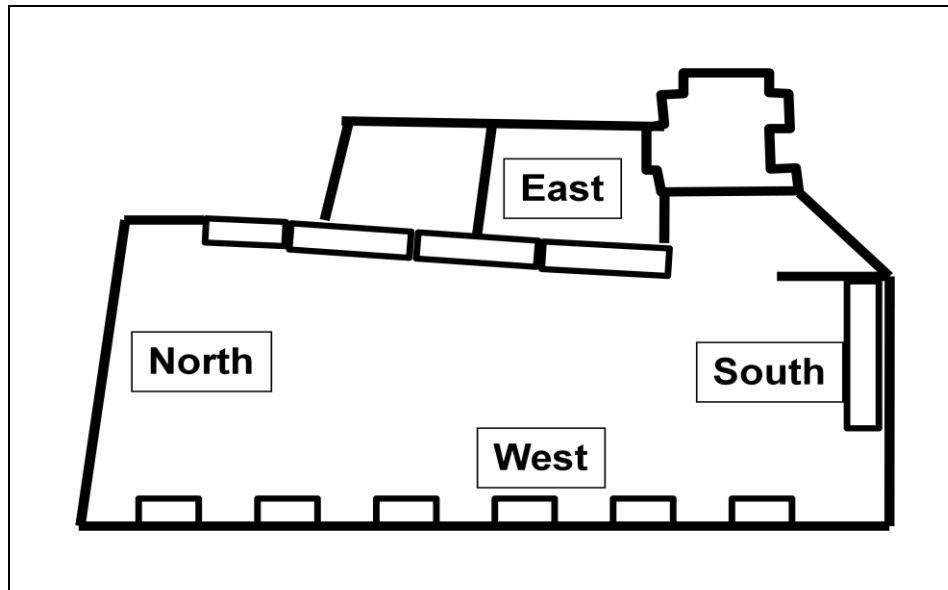
Assembly Instructions for George Knapp's 25mm Alamo Model March 2009

Here is a schematic of the Alamo as it stood in 1836. It is useful for the dimensions given. In 25mm scale, 1 inch equals 6 feet. Therefore, at 243.75 feet, the north wall would be about 40.5 inches on the wargame table. Keep these measurements in mind as you construct your Alamo.



The complete 25mm Alamo model consists of card stock printed pages. Please disregard the page numbers printed on the card stock sheets themselves. I recommend reinforcing the model with matte board or some other suitable material to give it additional rigidity. When completed, the model may look something like this, but you should feel free to assemble your model based on your vision of what the Alamo may have looked like in 1836.

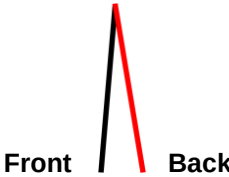


Each page in this set is part of the Alamo model you see above. I have included extra pieces so that you can arrange your Alamo as you wish.

Except for the earthen ramps, all the pieces follow the same basic design and assemble the same basic way. Each piece is printed so that it shows the front and back of the object.

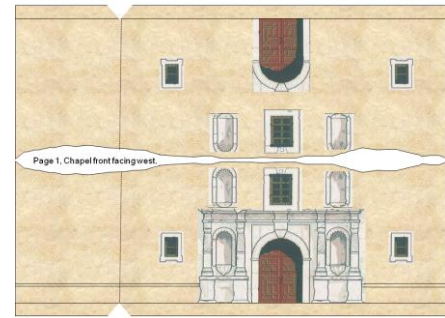
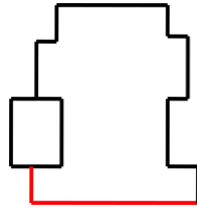
When you fold a piece in half, you can see the front on one side and the back on the other. Near the bottom of each piece is an extra piece of paper that you can fold out to make a base.

Here's an example:

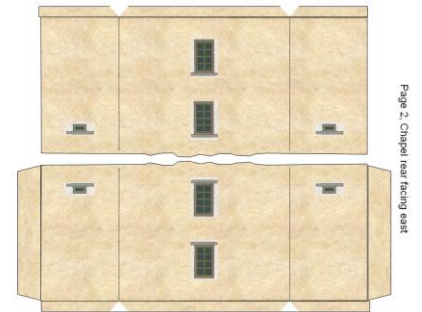
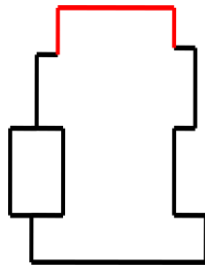

Now you can attach the base to whatever you choose.

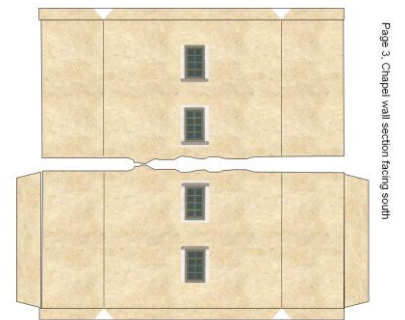
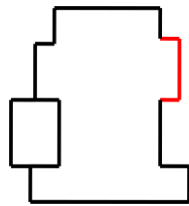
Chapel front, facing west. Note the fold in the piece's north end.



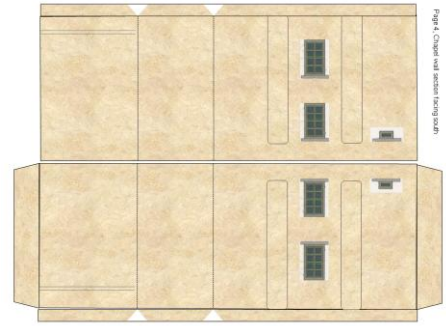
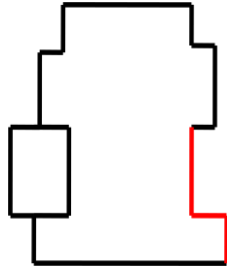
Chapel rear, facing east. Note the two folds on either end and the tabs for attaching this piece to its neighbors.



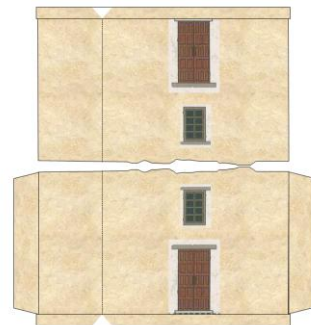
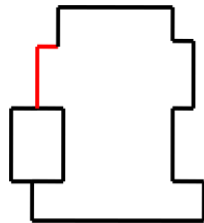
Chapel wall section, facing south. Note the two folds and the tabs.



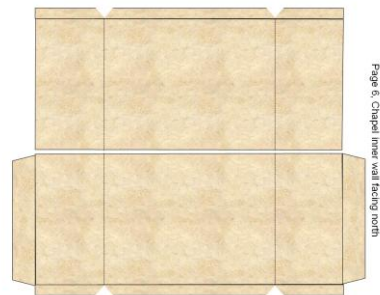
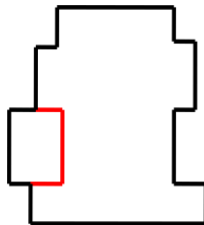
Chapel wall section, facing south. Note the two folds in opposite directions and the tabs.



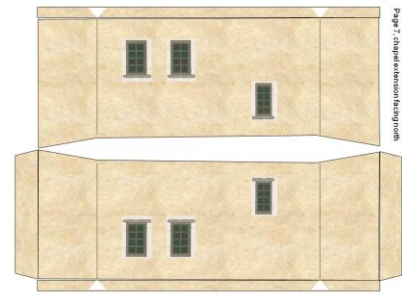
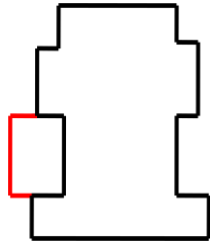
Chapel wall section, facing north. Note the fold and the tabs



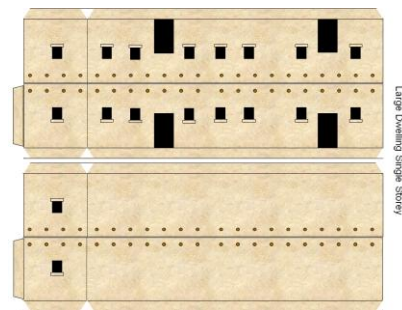
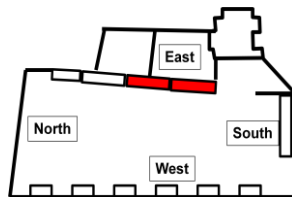

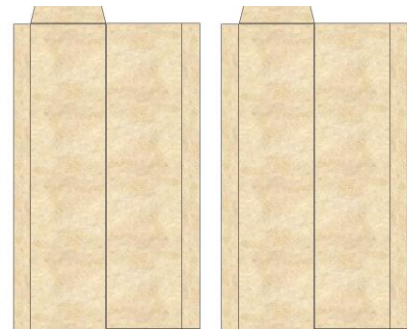
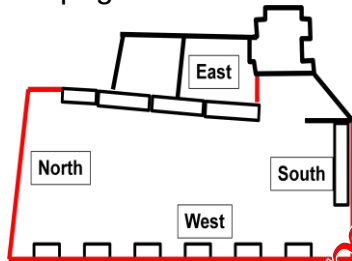
South Wall Arched Entryway. Trim as needed. Place along south wall.

Wall Section with door. Cut to fit between long barracks and chapel.



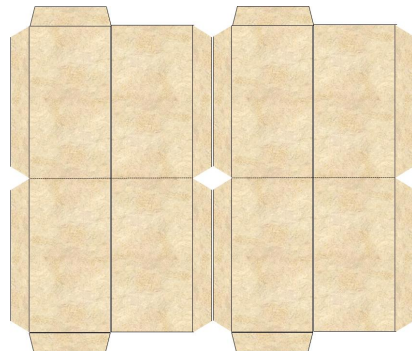
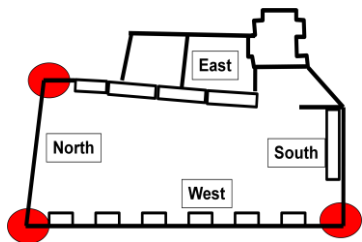
Page 21 Wall sections with doors. Trim as needed.

Wall Sections. Use whole sections or cut into smaller segments as you wish to fill in Alamo plaza perimeter. 12 segments on 6 pages.



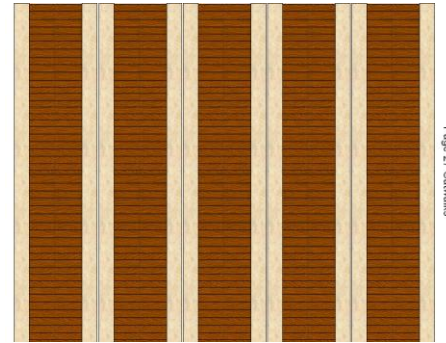
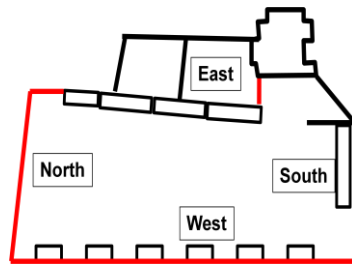

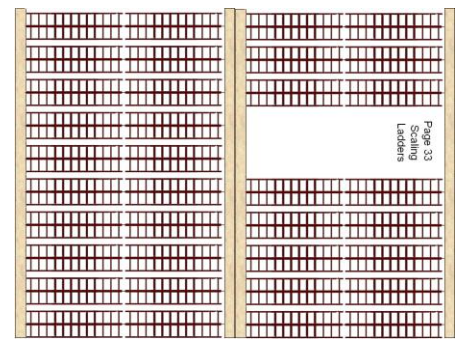
Low Walls. Meant to be used between long barracks and the low barracks. Some illustrations show the low wall extending in both directions. Extra materials to use as you see fit. 1 page



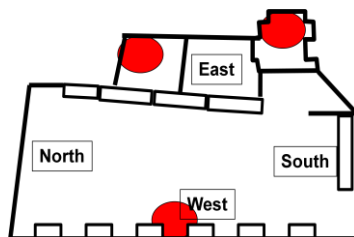

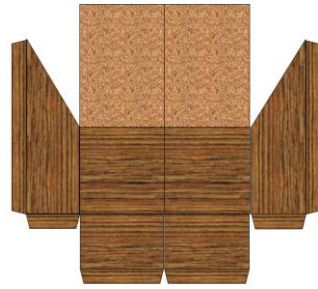
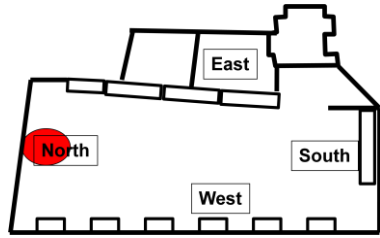
Scaling Ladders. 18 each on 1 page. Meant to accompany Mexican assault columns.



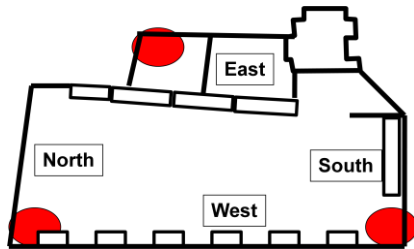
Earthen Ramps. Meant to fit squarely along wall or inside chapel east wall. 4 each on two pages.

2 pages.

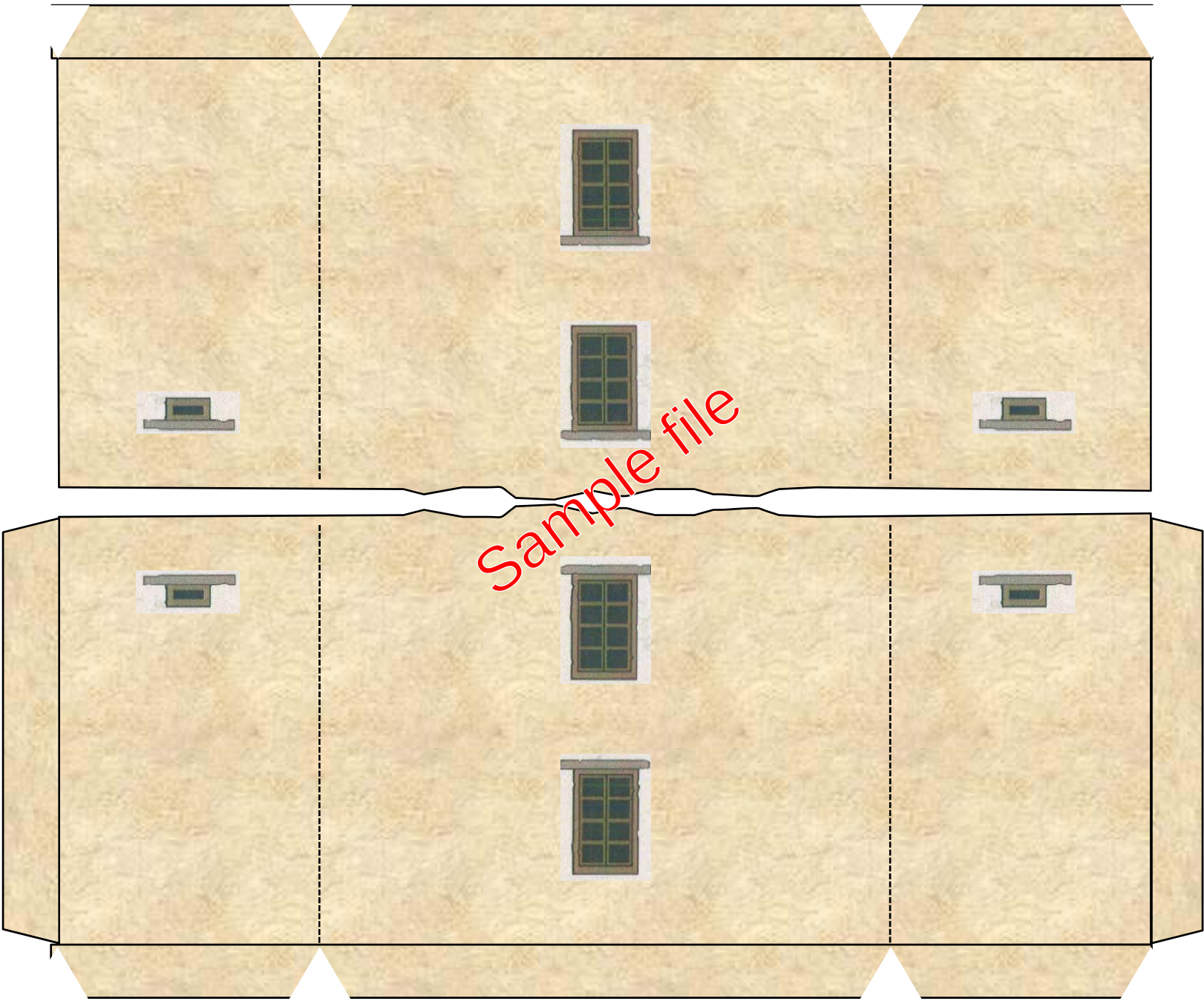
